They could paint your portrait and make you look as you are naturally... before they ever branched off into the styles they're best known for. They did it how everyone thought they should do it, then did it how they wanted to do it.

I really respect both hard work and creativity. I try to apply the same ideas. For example, I can photograph a classical portrait in manual mode, I can even do it with 35mm film. But I mostly like journalistic digital photography- catching the rare moments that are not posed. I think those smiles are the best and most genuine. Photoshop is my speciality. I can restore old photos, make brides glow, or make you into a Na'vi from the movie Avatar.



I am continuously learning and improving, and I believe that there is no room in art for snobbery. Someone may create something that you think is badly executed or just plain ugly, but hey, they got paid for it, so who are you to judge? I like to think that anyone can be an artist, they just haven't found their outlet. After all, if you judge a fish on how well it flies, it will forever think it is a failure
