Patrick also enjoys playing the guitar and singing. He plays for nursing home residents, and sings with the barbershop group, New River Harmony Chorus. He also enjoys restoring his old house. You can find Patrick in the MCX at Camp Lejeune working on a commissioned piece and selling his original works and prints.

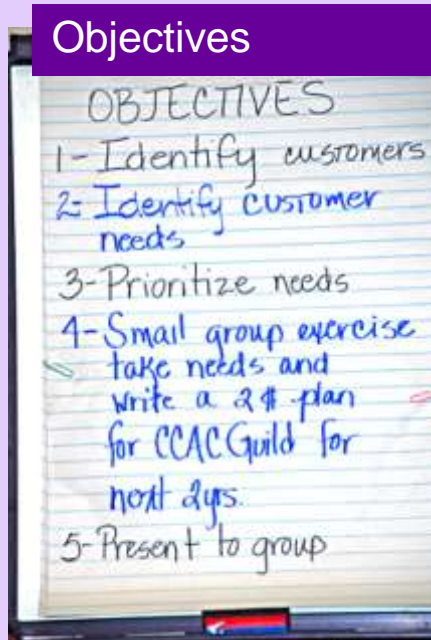

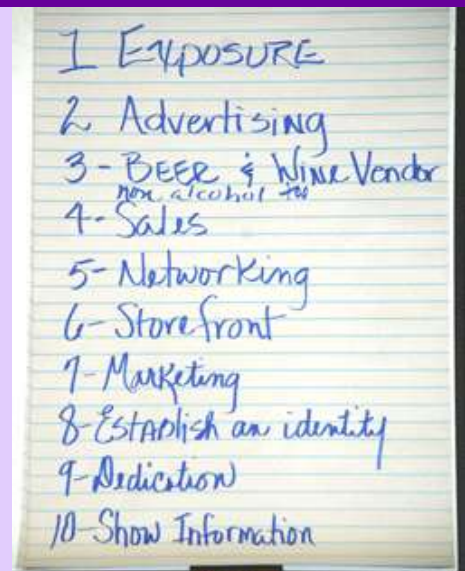

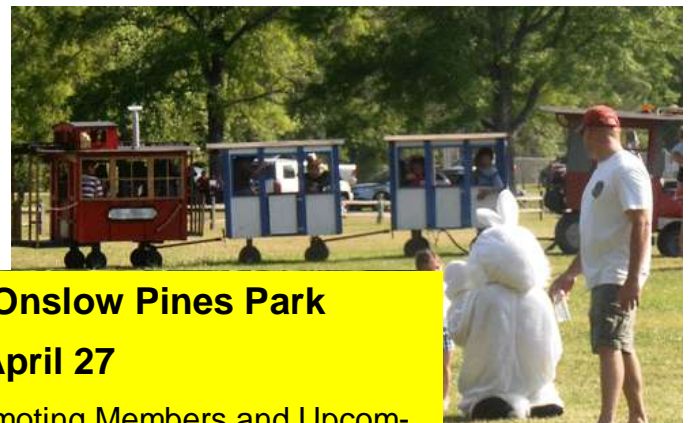
